## Registration Guide for Cub Scouts and Volunteers

*Pack your bags and get ready for a whirlwind trip around the world!  
All Cubs, Webelos and Volunteers are invited to join us at Day Camp!*

### **Cub Scout Day Camp is the best place to:**

- ◆ Have fun!
- ◆ Meet new and interesting scouts!
- ◆ Shoot BB Guns and practice Archery!
- ◆ Work on Advancement!
- ◆ Did we mention have FUN!



### **Here's how to sign up:**

- ◆ Choose a Pack Day Camp Representative. This person must attend Camp Orientation.
- ◆ Choose the date and location you want to attend Camp.
- ◆ **Legibly** complete the Pack Registration Form and individual Participation and Health Forms for each Scout **and** Volunteer.
- ◆ Fees are \$30 per participating Scout if paid Feb 12<sup>th</sup>-April 23<sup>rd</sup> 2010. After April 23<sup>rd</sup> fees are \$35 per Scout. Gold Card Packs earn an addition \$5 off per boy. No fee for Volunteers.
- ◆ Take all forms and payment to the Scout Office to reserve your spot. All payments must be made at the time of registration. No Exceptions.

### **Other information:**

- ◆ Registration is first come, first served. *So get your forms in early!*
- ◆ All Scouts must be registered with the Council prior to attending Camp. If you are unsure whether a Scout is registered contact the Scout Office at 376-4411.
- ◆ Fees are transferable, but not refundable. Changes must be submitted 5 days prior to your Camp or the Camp you wish to attend.
- ◆ You must submit a Tour Permit at least 14 days prior to your Camp. This is a National BSA requirement. Tour Permits are now online. Visit the Ore-Ida website to submit yours!
- ◆ The Medical Awareness box is for conditions Camp Staff need to know about. Details are located in the Leader's Guide.
- ◆ Each Scout will receive a Camp T-shirt, Camp patch and all materials at Camp. Volunteers may purchase shirts at Orientation or at Camp for \$12. Additional youth shirts will be for sale at Camp, as available.
- ◆ Your Pack's Day Camp Representative must attend Camp Orientation. You will receive your T-shirts, important information about your Camp and have an opportunity to ask questions.
- ◆ If your Pack is combined please list ALL Pack numbers on the Registration Form.
- ◆ Contact your District's Program Director for information about volunteering. We need your help to run a successful Camp. Contact information is available on the Registration Forms and in the Leader's Guide.
