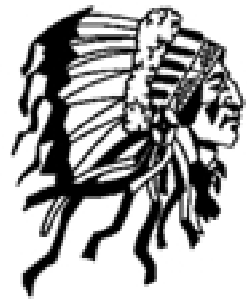
Recent happenings

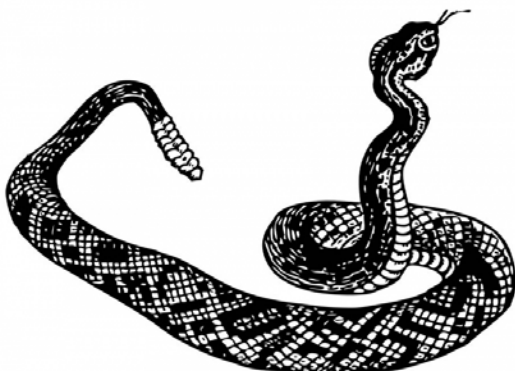

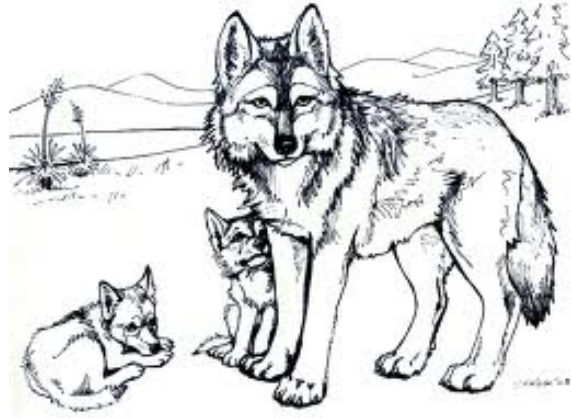

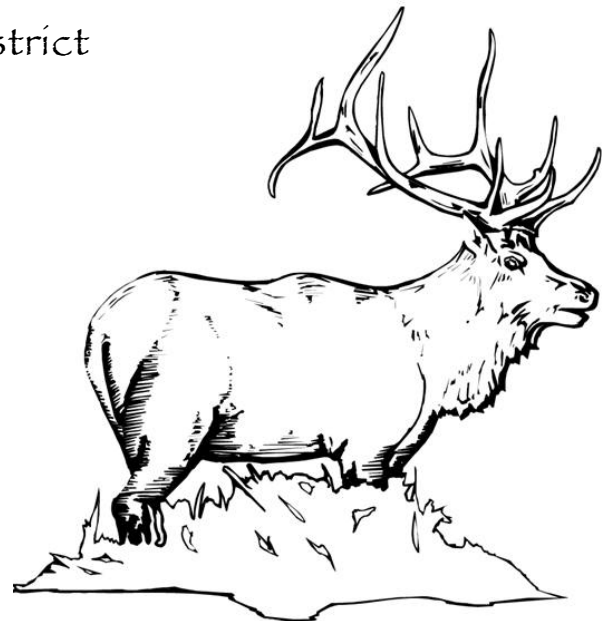
